El aroma del pasto recién cortado, una historia adulta en torno al amor, el deseo y la familia, está protagonizada por el reconocido actor argentino Joaquín Furriel, y la estrella del cine mexicano nominada al Oscar de la Academia, Marina de Tavira (*Roma*), quien tendrá su debut cinematográfico en Argentina.

El film cuenta la historia de Pablo (Joaquín Furriel), un profesor universitario que se involucra amorosamente con una alumna. En paralelo, Natalia (Marina de Tavira), profesora universitaria, se involucra amorosamente con un alumno. Dos historias espejadas, parecidas pero diferentes.

ACERCA DE LA DIRECTORA

CELINA MURGA

Nominada al Oso de Oro de Berlín, Celina Murga nació en Argentina y en 2012 fue seleccionada por el reconocido director de cine estadounidense Martin Scorsese para formar parte de la Rolex Mentor and Protégé Arts Initiative, pasando un año trabajando y aprendiendo bajo la tutela del Sr. Scorsese. Su primer largometraje, “Ana y los otros”, se estrenó en Venecia y fue aclamado en todo el mundo.

En 2008, “Una semana solos”, su segunda película, sigue el mismo camino siendo premiada en varios festivales de cine. En 2012 presentó como estreno mundial en el Forum de la Berlinale su documental “Escuela Normal”, ganando una Mención Especial con el Premio Caligari. En 2013, el Festival de Cine de Venecia la invitó a ser una de las 70 directoras participantes del proyecto VENEZIA 70 Future Reloaded. “La Tercera Orilla”, su última película, tuvo su estreno mundial en la Competencia Oficial de la Berlinale 2014. Fue una coproducción entre Argentina, Alemania y Holanda contó también con la producción ejecutiva de Martin Scorsese. Celina fue jurado en varios Festivales de Cine como Valdivia, Munich, Fribourg y Toulouse.

NOTAS DE LA DIRECTORA

“Esta historia surge a partir de ciertas conversaciones en torno al feminismo y la necesidad que nos surge de complejizar dicho concepto. Tanto yo, como directora del proyecto, como los guionistas con los que lo escribimos, creemos y valoramos

este momento histórico que estamos viviendo en relación a los derechos de la mujer.

De estas charlas surgió el guión. ¿Por qué no contar una historia que tenga el mismo recorrido, pero que sea atravesada en un momento por una mujer y luego por un hombre? ¿Qué cosas cambian en relación a la particularidad de cada género? ¿Qué cosas nos igualan? ¿Cómo se pone en juego el afuera, la mirada de los otros?

La película surge de la necesidad de repensarnos en relación a los vínculos y en relación a qué se espera de cada género en función de los roles de padre, madre, pareja. Y esto nos llevó a preguntarnos sobre la idea de familia y matrimonio.

El camino que encontramos para contar esta idea propone una estructura muy particular que, de alguna manera, condiciona y provoca ciertas ideas de puesta en escena. Dicha estructura se propone como un espejo, donde se suceden dos historias muy similares: una estará protagonizada por Natalia, la otra por Pablo. De alguna manera una es la contracara de la otra. Las historias serán muy parecidas, pero habrán claras situaciones y acciones que darán variaciones a los conflictos planteados. El objetivo de estas variaciones es invitar al espectador a reflexionar o al menos a hacerse preguntas sobre las cuestiones de género.

En cuanto a la selección de los actores, me entusiasmó mucho la idea de trabajar con Joaquín (Furriel) en un registro totalmente diferente al cual se lo suele ver en el cine, poniendo el cuerpo a un personaje y un conflicto enfocado en las relaciones humanas y en descubrir los matices que hacen a la complejidad de los vínculos familiares. Aquí lo veremos personificando a un profesor de la Facultad de Agronomía, en un tono actoral más naturalista. Con él pudimos hacer un proceso largo de ensayos en donde su gran compromiso actoral y su genuino interés en la historia y sus temas hizo crecer un montón al personaje que estaba planteado en el guión. Siempre me interesó mucho el trabajo de ensayos con los actores y todo lo que puede surgir del cuestionar al guión y a los personajes en este proceso. Fue una hermosa experiencia transitar este camino con él.

A Marina (de Tavira) la conocía principalmente por su actuación en el film "Roma" y me pareció muy interesante trabajar con una imagen nueva para mí. Lo que más me impactó en los primeros encuentros con ella (vía zoom) fue la comprensión de la temática de la película, del material y del conflicto y del personaje. Enseguida nos entendimos pudiendo profundizar en los temas que atraviesa el personaje como mujer, madre e hija. Nuestras charlas me hicieron dar cuenta de que un tema que a priori parece tan argentino (la mirada feminista y su fuerte impacto en la sociedad actual), es algo completamente universal".

Marina de Tavira nació en la ciudad de México. Tiene una destacada trayectoria como actriz en cine, teatro y televisión. Fue nominada al Óscar por su participación en la película "Roma" de Alfonso Cuarón, y fue acreedora del premio más importante de la cinematografía mexicana a mejor actriz, el premio Ariel. En teatro ha protagonizado obras de Bertold Brecht, Harold Pinter, David Mamet, Ximena Escalante, entre otros. En cine ha trabajado con directores como Rodrigo Plá (en la película ganadora del Premio León del Futuro en Venecia 2007), Carlos Carrera, Issa López, Mariana Chenillo, Hari Sama, además de Alfonso Cuarón. Sus trabajos más recientes en televisión incluyen la serie "Ingobernable", para Netflix, y "Falco", para Amazon dirigida por Ernesto Contreras. Su trabajo ha sido nominado y premiado por diversas asociaciones de críticos y periodistas en México y el mundo.

NOTAS DE MARINA

"Lo que me atrajo al leer el guión fue que hay un recorrido actoral muy interesante para un personaje en esta etapa de mi vida. Como que el recorrido, el momento de la vida de Natalia, lo que le está pasando en relación a su matrimonio, lo que le sucede con el otro personaje, son temáticas en las que sin dudas quería indagar. También me atrajo el tono en el que está escrita, que es como la vida misma, su cotidianeidad y al mismo tiempo su profundidad.

He visto todas las películas de Celina (Murga) y lo que más me impactó fue su registro naturalista, cuasi documental en donde se mezclan actores que parecen personas de la vida real. Me dieron muchas ganas de conocerla y trabajar con ella.

Estoy muy emocionada ya que es la primera vez que trabajo en una película argentina. Siento que Argentina y México son países hermanos. He visto mucho cine argentino, tengo muchos compañeros y compañeras, actrices y actores en México que son originarios de Argentina o que de alguna u otra forma se fueron para México. He trabajado con varios actores argentinos pero nunca lo había hecho aquí (en Argentina), y es un lugar al cual tenía muchas ganas de venir porque sé que tiene todo un mundo de amor al teatro, toda esa efervescencia de ficciones interesantes, de grandes directores y directoras, estoy muy contenta. Hace poco que llegué pero puedo decir que me siento como en casa”.

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SYNOPSIS

A male professor at the university is in conflict with his own roles as husband, father and teacher. The eventual relationship with a female student highlights his crisis. As in a mirror, a female professor, also in crisis, has an eventual relationship with a male student.

The duplicate story questions the power relations between genders. How do a woman and a man react to the same situation? How does the environment respond?

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

This story came about from conversations around the subject of feminism and the need that came about for us to discuss this concept in a more complex manner. I believe in and value this historic moment that we are living through in Argentina and the world in relation to the struggle for women’s rights. In personal terms, it is the most powerful historical moment – with the greatest level of awareness and participation – that I have experienced directly. I celebrate each moment of this era of awakening and change. I am absolutely certain of its unique and necessary character. It is perhaps for this reason that, also, I ask myself many questions in relation to genders and I observe in many men around me an uneasiness in relation to how to reconstitute, how to rethink themselves faced with this powerful, decisive and adrenaline-filled paradigm change.

From this uneasiness comes this project. Why not tell a story that has the same journey, one version traveled by a man and the other by a woman? What things change in relation to each gender? What

things make us equal? What gestures and actions do we replicate as men and women, responding to what is expected of our gender? How does that which is outside of us, the gaze of others, come into play? What is seen, what is and what seems to be? How do these questions intertwine with the social gaze in relation to gender? Are we women good only because of our genitalia? Are all men equally sexist and condemnable just for being men?

From the perspective of gender, the film aims to propose that patriarchy manifests itself in the way of connecting with the most vulnerable. It is a cultural structure that cuts across all of us, independent of our biological sex. Everyone, men and women, today are becoming part of this questioning of that power structure. However, what happens to personal and intimate relationships in light of all this?

Further, in this concrete context, the story develops from two characters in crisis. Natalia and Pablo are people going through profound crises that are causing them to make decisions that are perhaps unforeseeable for them. They hesitate, take action, make mistakes and do not control what they do. Both of them experience what is happening to them as a great personal dilemma that falls between their duties as teachers and their profound desires and inner personal crisis. The path we have found to talk of this idea proposes a very particular structure that, in some way, restricts and provokes certain ideas of mise en scène. This structure aims to be a mirror in which two very similar stories take place: one about Pablo and the other about Natalia. In some way, one is the flipside of the other.

The stories are very similar, but there will be clear situations and actions that will offer variations upon the conflicts posed. The objective of these variations is to invite the audience to reflect upon them, or at least to question.

The film's search will consist in transcending the binary masculine-feminine dichotomy in order to think of ourselves as human beings who inhabit a society with a patriarchal origin that is in clear and necessary deconstruction. Our intention is to uphold the need to continue moving forward together. I am always interested in putting ideas in tension, searching for complexity in counterpoint to telling of a closed and hermetic discourse that proposes a single and linear truth. Because, as Jean Claude Carriere says: "film is everything except a conclusion".

ABOUT THE FILMMAKER

Celina Murga was born in Parana, Argentina in 1973. She studied film direction at Universidad del Cine. In 2003 she directed her first feature film: "Ana and the Others", which premiered at Venice and was acclaimed all around the world. In 2008, "A Week Alone", her second film, followed the same path at Venice Film festival being awarded in several film festivals.

In 2009 she was selected by the renowned American film director Martin Scorsese to take part of the Rolex Mentor and Protégé Arts Initiative, spending a year working and learning under the mentorship of Mr. Scorsese.

In 2012, she presented as World Premiere at the Forum of the Berlinale, her documentary "Normal School", winning a Special Mention at the Caligari Award.

In 2013, Venice Film Festival invited her to be one of the 70 directors participating in the project VENEZIA 70. Future Reloaded. In this project, each film director shot a one minute short film talking about the future of cinema. This feature film premiered at Venice Film Festival.

"The Third Side of the River " was presented as a World Premiere at the Official Competition of the Berlinale 2014. It was a co-production between Argentina, Germany and Holland with the executive production of Martin Scorsese.

Celina has been jury member in several Film Festivals as MAr del Plata, Valdivia, Munich, Fribourg and Toulouse. She also works as a teacher.

ABOUT THE CAST

MARINA DE TAVIRA | NATALIA

Marina de Tavira is a mexican theatre, film and television actor.

Her career has mainly developed on the mexican stage working with the most prestigious directors. She has played the leading parts in plays from Bertold Brecht, Harold Pinter, David Mamet, Ximena Escalante, David Hevia, Nina Raine, among others.

In cinema, she has worked with directors such as: Rodrigo Pla in the film "La Zona" which won the 'Leone d'Oro Award' for the 'BEST DEBUT' at the 2007 Venice Film Festival. She has also worked with Carlos Carrera, Issa Lopez, Marina Chenillo, Hari Sama, Alfonso Cuarón (in his film "ROMA"), Katina Medina Mora, Lisa Joy and Celina Murga.

In 2017 she performed under the direction of Alfonso Cuarón in the multi-award-winning film "Roma", where she played 'Ms. Sofia', a character that earned her an Academy Award nomination, as well a Platinum Award nomination, both for Best Supporting Actress category. She won the Ariel Award in the same category.

She played the voice for "Blindness" created by the Donmar Warehouse and showcased in Mexico, which received the Metropolitan Award for the best show during the pandemic in Mexico. Her most recent work on television is "Now and Then" for Apple TV+, directed by Gideon Raff.

JOAQUÍN FURRIEL | PABLO

Joaquín Furriel was born on August 26, 1974, in the city of Lomas de Zamora. At the age of thirteen, he had his first contact with theater through a workshop at his school. Years later, he studied at the Conservatory of DramaKc Arts

In 1994 he experienced his first parKcipaKon as a student in the cast of students of the E.N.A.D, The Story of Juan Moreira, by Eduardo GuKérrez, On Crime and Punishment, by Fyodor Dostoyevski, mime-theater versions of the masters Roberto Escobar and Igor Lerchundi, touring several internaKonal fesKvals in Brazil, France, Spain and Georgia as well as doing a naKonal tour.

The works were awarded at international festivals.

In 1997 he graduated from the National Conservatory of DramaKc Arts

ALFONSO TORT | HERNÁN

Film and theater actor, graduated from EMAD (Multidisciplinary School of Dramatic Arts of Uruguay). His first leading role in film was in 2001 in the emblematic film "25 Watts" directed by Pablo Stoll and Juan Pablo Rebella. For this performance he received the award for Best Male Performance at the III Buenos Aires International Independent Film Festival (BAFICI).

Another of his notable films is "The Night of 12 Years" directed by Álvaro Brechner. For this performance he received the award for Best Male Performance at the Huelva Ibero-American Film Festival 2018 and the award for Best Actor by the Association of Film Critics of Uruguay 2018.

For his most recent leading role "A Blue Bird" directed by the Argentinian Ariel Rotter, he received the award for best actor at the 32nd edition of the Biarritz Latin American Film Festival.

His next film premiere will be "The aroma of freshly cut grass" directed by the Argentinian Celina Murga, to be presented at the 23rd edition of the Tribeca Film Festival.

Of his work for television series stands out his performance in "El Reino I y II" directed by the Argentinian director Marcelo Piñeyro and also his performance in the series "Alternative Therapy" by the Argentinian director Ana Katz.

His last theatrical performance was the interpretation of the monologue "The most beautiful body that will have been found in this place" by the playwright and theater director José María Miró who in 2022 will receive the National Prize for Dramatic Literature of Spain for this text.

ROMINA PELUFFO | CARLA

Her theater debut was in 2003 with Medeamaterial, by Heiner Müller, adapted and directed by the renowned Uruguayan playwright, actor and director Alberto Rivero. Since then she has worked mainly in the film industry. She played roles in the films El último tren [The last train] (Diego Arsuaga, 2002), Whisky (Stoll / Rebella, 2004), 3 (Pablo Stoll, 2011), Alelí (Leticia Jorge, 2020), Desperté con un sueño [I woke up with a dream] (Pablo Solarz, 2022), Naufragios [Shipwrecks] (Vanina Spataro, 2024) and El tema del verano [The summer theme] (Pablo Stoll; in post-production) and in the short films Total disponibilidad [Total Availability] (Adrián Biniez, 2008), 60 Primaveras [60 candles] (A. Guevara / L. Jorge, 2014), Tooth Fairy (J. Segovia, G. Torrens, 2017), among others.

Her latest work in films is El aroma del pasto recién cortado [The freshly cut grass], by Celina Murga, which will soon premiere at the Tribeca Film Festival.

She has also played roles in multiple TV and streaming services series: Barrabrava, (2023/Amazon Prime), El mejor infarto de mi vida [The best heart attack of my life] (in post-production/Disney),

Angel, (in post- production/TV Ciudad UY), Es Amor? [Is it love?] (in post-production/Coral Cine UY), among others .

In 2018 she launched her musical career with the release of Obsesa [Obsessed], an album that got three nominations for the "Graffiti", the most important music awards in the Uruguayan music industry. In 2020 she released her second album, Piel Fina [Thin skin], which got four nominations. She starred in the clips of the release singles from both albums: Obsesa, directed by Pablo Stoll, and No Se Va, directed by Ana Guevara and Leticia Jorge. In 2022, alongside Gonzalo Silva, she released Temporal, her third studio album, under the label Little Butterfly Records, also nominated for the 2023 Graffiti.

EMANUEL PARGA | GONZALO

Emanuel Parga is an Argentine actor, musician, director and theatrical illuminator.

He studied acting at the National University of the Arts in Buenos Aires. In parallel with the institutional framework, he studied acting and theater training with renowned directors such as Ricardo Bartis and Ciro Zorzoli, among others. He was part of multiple casts directed by prestigious directors of the Buenos Aires scene, participating in various international festivals.

In 2020 he was selected to be part of the cast of THE SNOW SOCIETY, a film directed by Catalan Juan Antonio Bayona, nominated for the 2024 Oscars. Winner of 12 Goya Awards, it became the second most viewed film on Netflix. He is currently working on different productions, developing his acting career and integrating the new generation of Latin American actors

VERÓNICA GEREZ | LUCIANA

Verónica Gerez is an Argentine actress, singer, and songwriter, born in 1990 in Quilmes, Buenos Aires. Her artistic journey encompasses a wide array of mediums, ranging from music to film and theater.

In the music realm, Verónica contributed to prominent bands such as Pequeña Orquesta de Trovadores (2009-2016) and Los Niños y Bestia Música (2015-2020), the latter alongside Moma Iturri. Through these projects, she graced numerous local and international stages, leaving her mark with recorded albums.

Regarding her acting prowess, Verónica honed her skills under the tutelage of esteemed professionals like Paula Grinszpan, Fran Ure, and Vico Roland. Her cinematic debut came in 2014 with a standout performance in "Cómo funcionan casi todas las cosas," earning her the Best Actress award at the Mar del Plata Film Festival in 2016. Since then, she has continued to captivate audiences on the silver screen, earning accolades such as the SAGAI Best Argentine Breakthrough Performance Actor for Best Newcoming Actress in "Husek" in 2021. She is currently a vital member of PalestraFilms, contributing to acclaimed productions like "Palestra," which received the FIPRESCI Award for Best Feature Film in 2021, and "Estertor" (2022), honored with the FICX60 Gijón 2022

award, with their new project "Los Bobos" currently in production.

In the realm of theater, Verónica has graced various productions, including plays at the prestigious Cervantes National Theatre like "Tiestes y Atreo" (by Emilio García Wehbi) and "Familia No Tipo y la nube maligna" (by Chaud y Tarrío). She has also delivered captivating performances in productions like "Lo único que quiero es bailar" (by Josefina Gorostiza), "Piramidal" (by Estudio QP), "Una obra más real que la del mundo" (by La mujer mutante), and "La espesura de los bosques" (by Paula Cancela).

Looking ahead, Verónica's schedule is brimming with exciting projects. In 2024, audiences can anticipate her enthralling performances in the play "Ha muerto un puto" by Gustavo Tarrío and in "Derecho de piso" by Ana Schimelman and Ian Shifres. Additionally, she will dazzle on the silver screen with the premieres of "El olor del pasto recién cortado" by Celina Murga and "Los renacidos" by Santiago Esteves.

LUCÍA OSORIO (Co-Writer)

Lucía Osorio is a graduate of the Universidad del Cine de Buenos Aires and is part of the Creative Writing master's cohort of the UNTREF (Bs. As.). Her first documentary feature film, "Our nighttime story" (2018) was part of the International Opera Prima Competition at the 6th FIDBA, and her novel "Ghosts are afraid of dogs" is published in Argentina by Hexágono Editoras (2024). She directed the short film "Souvenir" (2016), part of the official selection of the 12th Berlinale Talents Buenos Aires 2017. She is co-scriptwriter of the film "The smell of freshly cut grass", by Celina Murga, Professor at the Universidad del Cine de Buenos Aires, and content creator of the digital multi platform @bibliotacora.

JUAN VILLEGAS (Co-Writer and Executive Producer)

Juan Villegas was born in 1971 in Buenos Aires. His short films, *Rutas y veredas* (1995) and *2 en 1 auto* (1998) were his first experiences as director. He directed four feature films: *Sábado*, *Los suicidas*, *Ocio* and *Las Vegas*, and two documentaries: *Victoria* and *Los trabajos y los días*. He created Tresmilmundos Cine, a production company among with Celina Murga un 2005. Por esta última película obtuvo premios en los Festivales de Guadalajara y Huelva, y fue elegido mejor actor por los Premios Sur y Cóndor de Plata, los principales premios a la actividad cinematográfica de la Argentina. En los últimos años fue protagonista de dos de las series argentinas más destacadas: "El reino" (Netflix) y "Jardín de bronce" (HBO). Su interpretación de "Hamlet" y "Final de partida", en teatro, fue ampliamente reconocida por el público y la crítica.

NOTAS DE JOAQUÍN

"Me interesó trabajar en esta película porque no tengo mucho recorrido en el cine más bien autoral, yo no creo en los géneros ni en los títulos, me parece que las películas tienen o no tienen vida, pasan o no pasan. Por supuesto que por el tipo de realizadora que es Celina, la atmósfera que genera su cine, lo vincular, lo que pasa con sus personajes y también por la producción, se genera una particularidad. Una garantía, una apuesta distinta".

Lo interesante para mí del guión es que muestra el trabajo que hace la sociedad patriarcal sobre las personas de una manera muy poco evidente, pero que está, y me pareció muy lúcido cómo se entrelaza esta red entre los dos personajes, el femenino y el masculino.

Creo que hay una poderosa reacción de parte del poder masculino, concentrado. Lo podemos llamar patriarcado y de muchas maneras, lo que sí es claro que la cultura, la historia de la cultura está contada desde la perspectiva masculina.

El desafío de hacer esta película fue descubrir de lo que uno se defiende porque, lamentablemente, cuando uno cree que sabe algo, ese saber no es algo que uno pueda utilizar en cualquier campo de trabajo.

El trabajo de campo siempre se modifica, es dinámico como el presente también lo es, y noté que al principio estaba un poco reactivo a algunas cuestiones que me costaban y rápidamente fui mejorando la escucha, fui tratando de trabajar lo más honestamente posible con mis inseguridades también como actor para poder interpretativamente estar integrado a lo que deseaba que sucediera Celina en la película con el personaje.

Creo que hicimos un trabajo minucioso, muy placentero, y es hermoso cuando sucede eso. Estoy muy habituado a trabajar así, sobre todo en teatro, que los tiempos de ensayo son diferentes y valoro mucho la visión, el cuidado y la perseverancia que tuvo Celina. También la perspicacia en el uso de las herramientas con las que me fue dirigiendo para poder habitar un personaje que al principio podría decir que no tiene expresiones o situaciones muy taxativas, sino que se mueve en un lugar de mucha duda.

En estos tiempos en los que vivimos es una zona no sólo poco explorada, sino poco estimulada, así que fue muy interesante”.
